{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Carolina Freight Express, Inc. (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On April 17, 2020, Tim Britt, on behalf of Respondent, requested an administrative hearing regarding the alleged carrier violations in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed to by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be schedule upon the filing of a request for an administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} The parties in this case are directed to participate in a telephonic prehearing conference on July 14, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone.
