I am hereby requesting a waiver for the following Ohio Administrative Codes; (4901:2-7-02) (4901:2-7-12) (4901:2-7-13) (4901:2-7-22)

When I received the initial notice from the commission back in the October, I immediately had handed the notice to my transportation manager directly insisting that they pay the ticket. He stalled for about three weeks before he finally returned the notice with a response. By the time he had informed me that they would pay half of the ticket it was already past the 30 days appeal period that the commission outlined in the initial notice. After having received a second notice from the commission outlining the time that I was allotted to pay the ticket or appeal the violation I had already submitted the payment. The following month I received a notice of apparent disqualification and realized that the reason for disqualification resulted from the ticket being paid. My knowledge at the time was that I was at risk of losing my license if the ticket wasn't paid within the given time. I was very conflicted whether to try my case with the Commission or with PennDOT. I decided to reach out to the Commission through the Ohio Gov. Office in pursuit to resolve my disqualification in Pennsylvania by possibly getting the ticket dropped.
