MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

SunSea Energy OH, LLC ("Applicant") hereby respectfully requests this honorable Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") to enter an order pursuant to the Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4901-1-24(D) to protect certain confidential and proprietary data and information of the Applicant that has been included with the Applicant's submission of Material Changes to its electric supplier application ("Material Changes"). Specifically, the Applicant requests that the Commission treat Exhibits C-3, C-5, C-6 and C-7 as confidential and proprietary. Each of these exhibits contains commercially sensitive and proprietary information that constitutes a trade secret.

The Applicant is not a publically traded company and, therefore, its personal and business financial information is highly confidential and is available only to those individuals on a need to know basis. The Applicant is concerned that the disclosure, of the above-mentioned exhibits would provide the Applicant's competitors with an unfair advantage and valuable insight into the Applicant's financial information and business activities. Therefore, the Applicant believes that the disclosure of such personal and business financial information could impede its launch and growth and would likely result in substantial economic damages to the Applicant.
