{¶ 1} Staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Real Deal Delivery Service (RDDS) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On May 28, 2020, RDDS requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} On July 2, 2020, an Entry was issued scheduling a July 21, 2020 settlement conference for the above-captioned case.
