Though the proposed site for this project is directly across Vernon Tharp St. from the Veterinary Medical Center, we were not informed. It impacts our air quality, as well as that of the horses and farm animals housed only yards away.

Furthermore, does it make sense to remove large trees and greenhouses in the name of lessening the carbon footprint with a fracking- supplied natural gas power plant.

Finally, hundreds of parking spots have recently been removed from the Sisson Parking lot to make room for another building. We really cannot afford to lose any more. Lack of parking is a huge stress on faculty, staff and students at the VMC. This will increase the stress to a breaking point.
