To Whom It May Concern:

On Friday, September 4, 2020 at approximately 11:15am, Erin Bowser, representing Paulding Wind Farm IV LLC (PWFIV), notified John Pawley of the Ohio Power Siting Board by phone that one wind turbine of the PWFIV facility had experienced an incident overnight which resulted in damage to one of the wind turbine's blades. At approximately 2:00pm on September 4, 2020, in accordance with Condition 21 of the PWFIV Certificate, Erin Bowser followed up the phone call with a notice via email to Mr. Pawley and other relevant Ohio Power Siting Board staff. Below is a summation of the email correspondence and the incident reported:

At some point before dawn on September 4, 2020 one blade from one wind turbine experienced damage. There were no injuries nor any property other than the wind turbine itself damaged. The landowner whose parcel this wind turbine is located on has been notified as has the Paulding County Sherriff. The wind turbine is currently inoperable and in shutdown mode and the area has been secured. We understand that staff from the Ohio Power Siting Board will be visiting the site this afternoon and our site management team will be available to host that visit in a safe manner. The incident is under investigation by PWFIV LLC and Vestas (the wind turbine supplier), and a written report will be drafted and shared with OPSB in the coming weeks.
