On 08/17/2020, a vehicle operated by MCJUNKIN ROLL OFFS INC, and driven by, PEARSON, RICHARD A was inspected within the state of Ohio. As a result of discovery of the following violation(s) of the Commission's rules, Staff of the Commission timely notified RICHARD A PEARSON pursuant to rule 4901:2-7-07, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), that it intended to assess a civil forfeiture against RICHARD A PEARSON in the following amount:


Within 30 days of this notice you must either: 1) pay the assessed civil forfeiture or, 2) submit a written Request for an Administrative Hearing.
