## REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On November 10, 2020, Agile Network Builders, LLC (Agile) filed a zero-day notice filing for a change in ownership (CIO) pursuant section 4901:1-06-29 of Administrative Code. Agile is authorized to provide competitive telecommunications services pursuant to certificate 90-9436.

Agile is notifying the Commission of a transfer of ownership as a result of a purchase of all the interest in IWG Holdings LLC holding the entire interest of InSite Wireless Group LLC which holds the entire interest of Agile IWG Holdings LLL, which in turn owns all the interest in Agile; by ATI LLC via a securities purchase agreement. Upon completion of this transaction Agile will indirectly be a wholly owned subsidiary of ATI LLC. ATI LLC will hold, through it wholly owned and controlled entities, all of the interest of Agile.

Agile is a telephone company not providing BLES and filed all the required forms and attachments. However, since this transfer of ownership is completely transparent, no customer notice is required. As such, Agile did not provide a copy of a customer notice. Also, Agile states that this transaction is not pending approval with the Federal Communications Commission. Therefore, Staff finds that the CIO, as filed, meets all the requirements set forth in section 4901:1-06-29 of Administrative Code.

In conclusion, Staff finds Agile's CIO notice filing does not appear to be unjust or unreasonable; therefore, Staff recommends that this application be permitted to remain in effect.
