- Section 1. The Village of Stryker's Village Council hereby authorize the Williams County Commissioners to act as the governmental agent for purchasing and aggregation of electric power for the residents of Village of Stryker.
- Section 2. This resolution shall be copied to the Williams County Commissioners, One Courthouse Square, Bryan, Ohio 43506
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were so adopted in an open meeting of this Council. and that all formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compilance with all legal requirements.
- Section 4. This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure pursuant to ORC 731.30 because the immediate passage of the Resolution is necessary so that Stryker, OH may be included in a group effort to achieve the best electric rates possible for the Village of Stryker residents. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption
