Dear Ms. Troupe:

Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio), filed an Amendment, pursuant to O.A.C. Chapter 4906-3-11, on September 22, 2020, concerning a proposed project known as the C314V Central Corridor Pipeline Extension Amendment Project. The Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) Staff issued its report recommending approval by the OPSB, provided that certain conditions are satisfied:

- (1) The Applicant shall continue to adhere to all conditions of the Opinion, Order, and Certificate for the C314V Central Corridor Pipeline Extension project in Case No. 16-0253-GA-BTX following the route as amended through this amendment application.
- (2) The certificate authority provided in this case shall not exempt the facility from any other applicable and lawful local, state, or federal rules or regulations nor be used to affect the exercise of discretion of any other local, state, or federal permitting or licensing authority with regard to areas subject to their supervision or control.
- (3) The environmental specialist approved in Condition 28 of the original Opinion and Order shall be on site during the lateral jack and bore construction activities and installation of the approximate 300 feet of pipeline under Interstate 275.

Duke Energy Ohio agrees to satisfy these conditions should the OPSB decide to impose them.
