The Universal Service Fund Rider shall be assessed on all kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity distributed under this Schedule at the rates stated below, effective on a bills-rendered basis in the Company's first cycle billing unit for the month of January 2021.

\$0.0004213 per kWh for all kWh
\$0.0004213 per kWh for all kWh over 833,000 kWh

The Universal Service Fund is a statewide program which was established under Section 4928.51 of the Ohio Revised Code to be implemented by the Director of Development. The purpose of the fund is to provide qualified Low-Income Customers in Ohio with income-based bills and energy efficiency education programs.

The Universal Service charge for electric service as required by Distribution Tariff Sheets contained in this Schedule shall be the product of the billing kWh and the Universal Service Fund Rider.

This Rider will be assessed on each monthly bill, effective on a bills-rendered basis beginning January 1, 2021 for all Customers served under the Electric Distribution Service Tariff Sheets D17-D22 and D25 based on the following rates.
