## Dear Examiner Parrot:

On January 7, 2021, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a Notice of Deposition and Request for Production in these cases. On January 11, 2021, Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) filed a Motion for Protection regarding the Notice of Deposition and Request for Production, supported by an affidavit, showing that the circumstances of OCC's attempt to subvert the established process in this case as well as the Commission's discovery rules. The next day, an OCC administrative assistant announced via email that the depositions would not go forward. Two days later, OCC re-filed Notices of Deposition covering the same ground.

OCC's litigious gamesmanship of withdrawing and reissuing notices does not change the issues presented in the Company's Motion for Protection. If anything, OCC's replacement Notice of Deposition and Request for Production flouts the process even more by attempting to conduct depositions the day before comments are due in this case. Accordingly, the Company does not withdraw its Motion for Protection and it should continue to be considered as applicable to the OCC's ongoing course of conduct to pursue depositions and bypass the 20-day discovery deadline applicable to request for production.
