On 08/20/2020, a vehicle operated by ED BURDUE & CO LLC, and driven by, was inspected within the state of Ohio. As a result of discovery of the following violation(s) of the Commission's rules, Staff of the Commission timely notified ED BURDUE & CO LLC pursuant to rule 4901:2-7-07, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), that it intended to assess a civil forfeiture against ED BURDUE & CO LLC in the following amount:

A conference was conducted pursuant to Rule 4901:2-10, OAC, at which ED BURDUE & CO LLC had a full opportunity to present reasons why the violation(s) did not occur as alleged, mitigating circumstances regarding the amount of any forfeiture, and any other information relevant to the action proposed to be taken by the Staff.



As a result of the conference, staff has made a preliminary determination that the commission should assess a civil forfeiture against ED BURDUE & CO LLC in the following amount:


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4901:2- 5-03	-	Using a CMV not periodically inspected	\$ 800.00
<u>New Amount Due:</u>			\$15,300.00

Within 30 days of this notice you must either: 1) pay the assessed civil forfeiture or, 2) submit a written Request for an Administrative Hearing.

Failure to comply with either option above shall constitute a waiver of your right to further contest the violation(s) and will conclusively establish the occurrence of the violation(s). Such failure shall also constitute a waiver of your right to further contest liability to the State of Ohio for the civil forfeiture described in the notice and will result in the forfeiture amount being referred to the Ohio Attorney General's Office for collection. In addition, your Ohio operating authority and/or commercial driving privileges may be sanctioned as permitted by law.
