{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Central Transport LLC (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On December 15, 2020, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
