DBA Green Choice Energy (RPA Energy or Applicant) is an electric services company and retail natural gas supplier as defined in R.C. 4928.01 and 4929.01, is certified to provide competitive retail electric service (CRES) and competitive retail natural gas service (CRNGS) under R.C. 4928.08 and 4929.20, and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission pursuant to R.C. 4928.16 and 4929.24.
- [¶ 2] On February 18, 2021, the Applicant submitted an application to the Commission requesting waivers of Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-21-06(D)(1)(h), Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-21-06(D)(2)(a), Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-29-06(D)(6)(b), and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-29-06(E)(1). RPA Energy seeks waivers of certain rules governing the third-party verification (TPV) process for new customers enrolled through sales channels requiring TPV. Applicant contends that the requested waivers will enable RPA Energy to offer customers the ability to complete the verification process through digital confirmation. Applicant contends that digital TPV enables better, faster, more accurate enrollment verification and a greatly enhanced customer experience, without diminishing any consumer protections afforded by the Commission's rules.
