Per the February 2, 2021 Entry in this matter, The Dayton Power and Light Company d/b/a AES Ohio ("AES Ohio" or "the Company") provides the following update on the status of the above-referenced matter. AES Ohio attended the November 20, 2019 settlement conference where the parties left with some actions items to explore for potential resolution of the claims set forth in the Complaint. Unfortunately, follow-up yielded little success and the parties seemed to be headed toward an impasse. Due to the intervening COVID-19 pandemic, however, no further settlement conferences were held.

Given the span of time that has elapsed since the last settlement meeting, AES Ohio remains interested in exploring settlement to determine whether circumstances have changed since the parties last met. AES Ohio suggests having another settlement conference to be mediated by an attorney examiner once Ms. Johnson has provided proof of legal authority to act on behalf of Mr. Peagler. In the event no settlement conference is scheduled or a settlement cannot be reached after such conference, AES Ohio plans to file a dispositive motion.

AES Ohio thanks the Commission for the opportunity to provide a status report and remains ready to proceed in whatever manner determined by the Attorney Examiner.
