DP&L values you as a customer and makes every effort to keep you informed of changes that may affect your property. We are writing to share the improvements The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L") is making to an electric transmission substation that is close to your property. The work is being done on the Bath-Trebein 138kV transmission line which is located in Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio.

As described in the Letter of Notification Application, which was approved by the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") on January 9, 2020 (Case Number 19-1631-EL-BLN), the improvements will consist of reconductoring an existing 138kV overhead electrical transmission line that connects the existing Bath Substation to the existing Trebein Substation. The transmission line is approximately 4.6 miles long and located within an existing 100-foot-wide right-of-way. This project is being undertaken to comply with mandatory North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) reliability requirements. The improvements will strengthen the electric system and will improve reliability by ensuring that system voltages do not drop below minimum acceptable levels and relieve thermal loading issues under certain contingency conditions.

The entire reconductor project will be on existing DP&L property or right of way. However, in several cases, we will need to utilize access points located on individual properties. Landowners affected by this have already been contacted by DP&L representatives.

Actual construction for the project is scheduled to begin in March 1, 2021 and the project is expected to be in-service by June 2021. DP&L does not expect any customer interruptions of electric service because of this work. We understand the construction project can present a temporary inconvenience as we work to strengthen our infrastructure to provide safe, reliable electric service.






