**February 17, 2021**

- Why has Marion Township Zoning not received any application from your company for this project to date?
- Does the fence stay throughout the life of the project? Or is it removed after the site is put into use?
- Who can we contact for construction work?
- Why the choice of this farmland and not the vacant industrial land within the Marion County?
- Does this impact a solar project planned for Union County?
- What roads will be used for construction traffic? Can you guarantee us that there will not be construction vehicles going down residential streets?
- How many of Savion's projects are sited on farmland that was in agricultural production prior to your project?
- What considerations have you given to homeowners in close proximity to the project?
- Does the perimeter fencing restrict wildlife? What kind of perimeter fencing is put up? Has there been any consideration of planting cover that attracts beneficial insects?
- After the 30-year life is over, what happens to the ground on which the solar is placed?
- Is the farm ground currently zoned commercial?
- The project covers 970 acres, but not all of it is covered with solar panels. What will the remaining ground be covered with? And again, any consideration of native forbs or wildflowers to attract beneficial insects?
- How large is the substation structure?
- Do you avoid using productive farmland for your solar projects?
- Do the visual simulations show the panels as flat or tilted?
- How will construction traffic be managed?
- Who will be using the energy from this project?
- Has Savion worked with the Ohio Department of Agriculture?
