On April 1, 2021, East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Ohio (“DEO”) filed a statement informing the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“PUCO” or “Commission”) that the issues raised in the comments had been resolved.

In its Comments filed March 23, 2021, the Staff of the PUCO (“Staff”) recommended approval of DEO’s Application to adjust its Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement (“PIR”) Program Cost Recovery Charge, subject to the disallowance of plant additions associated with the 30-inch steel gas main failure located at 28000 Shaker Blvd., Pepper Pike, Ohio (“Incident”). The Staff also recommended that actual 2020 fourth quarter data, including costs recorded in the fourth quarter of 2020 related to the Incident, be audited in the next annual filing.

The Staff and DEO have resolved the issues raised in the Comments. The Staff agrees to withdraw the proposed disallowance of the Incident. The Staff and DEO agree that DEO shall remove the \$5,225.84 of the Incident remediation costs from the PIR revenue requirement. With respect to the invoiced amount of \$133,018.00 for which payment is being withheld pending litigation, the Parties agree that DEO shall make an adjustment in a future annual PIR filing, in the month and year that the amount was accrued, if that amount is not paid in full. The Staff reserves the right to review this accrued amount in a future annual PIR filing and confirm the appropriateness of any adjustment by DEO. Finally, the Staff and DEO agree that actual 2020 fourth quarter data be audited in the next annual PIR filing.
