MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES CORP D/B/A VERIZON ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES' REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

MCImetro Access Transmission Services Corp. d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon") respectfully requests pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(3)(iv) that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") review the Pooling Administrator's ("PA") denial of Verizon's request for numbering resources to meet a specific customer request that Verizon could not fulfill using its existing numbering resources. For the reasons set forth more fully below, Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and direct it to assign the requested blocks to Verizon.

Discussion

On March 16, 2021, Verizon¹ filed a request with the PA seeking two blocks of telephone numbers in the Hillcrest Ohio rate center in order to meet a customer request for a contiguous range of 2,000 direct inward dialing numbers ("DID") as a Pool Replinishment. *See* Exhibit 1, which is a true and correct copy of Verizon's Thousands Block Application Part 1A, Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Work Sheet, and the PA's denial thereof. Verizon's existing numbering inventory does not contain a contiguous range of numbers available to meet this customer need.

The PA denied Verizon's request on March 16, 2021 because we did not meet the MTE and/or Utilization requirements.

Verizon did not meet the MTE requirement threshold of 6 month or less (6.09, 9.082 months) however did meet the FCC's required 75% Utilization threshold (93.132%) in the Hillcrest OH rate center. *Id*.

A state commission may overturn the PA's decision based on the state commission's determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the requested numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(4). Similarly, the FCC has held that "a carrier should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." See Third Report and Order and Second Order on Reconsideration, In the Matter of Numbering Resource Optimization; Implementation of the Local Competition Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996; Telephone Number Portability, 17 FCC Rcd 252 (rel. Dec. 28, 2001) at ¶ 64. State commissions are permitted to grant such requests provided they are for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers, rather than "vanity numbers." Id.

In this case, Verizon's customer, Progressive Casualty Insurance Company, requires 2,000 contiguous DID numbers in Hillcrest, Ohio rate center to accommodate company growth at its 300 N. Commons Blvd. Mayfield Village, OH 44143 location in the Hillcrest OH rate center. *See* Exhibit 2, which is a true and correct copy of Progressive Casualty Insurance Company's letter explaining its business needs. The request includes a contiguous range of 2,000 DID numbers. The DID range should be square blocks of numbers (X000-X999) in the 440 NPA where the first position of last 4 digits in the phone number cannot begin with "9" to conform to the existing dialing plan. *Id.* At the time of this request the Hillcrest OH rate center

did not have 2 contiguous blocks available in the pool. Therefore we also are requesting a Pool Replenishment at the HILLCREST OH, rate center enabling availability of two contiguous Blocks of numbers to meet this customer's needs.

Conclusion

Wherefore, for the foregoing reasons, Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and request the PA for a Pool Replenishment in the Hillcrest OH rate center and direct the PA to grant Verizon's request to obtain two Thousand Blocks in the Hillcrest Ohio rate center to satisfy Progressive Casualty Insurance Company's need for 2,000 contiguous DIDs.
