Greendale Substation Expansion**

Dear Madam:

Duke Energy Ohio proposes to expand the existing 138-kV Greendale Substation by approximately 300 square feet (approximately 21 percent) to install approximately 50 feet of new fencing around a secondary oil containment berm. The substation expansion will expand the existing 138-kV Greendale Substation to improve onsite oil containment from potential underground transmission systems and add flood protection within the substation.
