

# AFFIDAVIT OF JOSEPH M. STORSIN, JR. IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Joseph M. Storsin, Jr., being first duly sworn in accordance with the law, deposes, and states:

1. I am over 18 years of age and have personal knowledge of the matters set forth herein.

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2. I am employed by FirstEnergy Service Company as Assistant Controller - FirstEnergy Utilities for FirstEnergy Corp. and a number of its subsidiary companies, including Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, "Companies").

3. I have reviewed and am familiar with the Schedules JMS-1-Supplemental and JMS-2-Supplemental to my Supplemental Testimony and Schedules TMA-1-Supplemental, TMA-2-Supplemental, and TMA-3-Supplemental to the Second Supplemental Testimony of Tracy M. Ashton filed under seal in the above-captioned proceedings (collectively, the "Confidential Schedules").

- 4. Schedules JMS-1-Supplemental and JMS-2-Supplemental contain projected net income and balance sheet information for each of the Companies, on an individual basis, based on a financial forecast of the Companies. Schedules TMA-1-Supplemental, TMA-2-Supplemental, and TMA-3-Supplemental rely on Schedules JMS-1-Supplemental and JMS-2-Supplemental to calculate prospective earnings and common equity for calendar years 2021 2024 for each of the Companies. All projected data are redacted from the public filings in these proceedings.
- 5. The information in the Confidential Schedules is the subject of efforts that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy. The Companies have treated all of the information in the Confidential Schedules that has been redacted as proprietary, confidential business information and as a trade secret. The information in the Confidential Schedules is not known to the public or those outside the Companies. The Companies will only provide this information to others under an appropriate protective agreement.
- 6. Further, in the ordinary course of business of the Companies, the information in the Confidential Schedules is treated as proprietary and confidential by the Companies and their

employees. Within the Companies, the financial information in the Confidential Schedules is not generally accessible by employees of the Companies, except for those employees who helped create it or need to rely on it to carry out their responsibilities. All employees are subject to nondisclosure agreements prohibiting the disclosure of this type of financial information, except as otherwise authorized. While the Companies' parent company discloses specific financial information in its public reporting on a consolidated basis, the information in the Confidential

The information in the Confidential Schedules also derives actual, independent value as a result of it not being generally known or readily ascertainable by those who might otherwise obtain economic value from its disclosure or use, such as competitors, suppliers or investors. This information could, if disclosed, be used by investors to make decisions regarding the purchase or sale of FirstEnergy Corp. stock, which would, in turn, affect the price of such stock. The public disclosure of this information would have a real effect on the financial position of the Companies, including potentially affecting the price of publicly traded stock and revealing proprietary details of the Companies' growth and operations strategies. Members of the public would not be able to obtain and compile this financial information, or to duplicate it, at the level of detail provided in the Confidential Schedules.
- 8. Because the Confidential Schedules contain forecasted financial information of the Companies, they are material nonpublic information under Regulation FD, 17 C.F.R. 243. As such, the release of this sensitive, nonpublic financial information could implicate disclosure requirements under Regulation FD, as well as other federal securities law concerns.
