Part I – Requirements:

Facilities-based Wireline applicants must obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Ohio prior to applying for CETC Designation.

Facilities-based Wireless applicants must register as a Wireless Service Provider in Ohio prior to applying for CETC Designation.

Part II – Requirements:

Demonstration of Rural Telephone Company Status

The Carrier provides that it meets at least one of the following four criteria for rural telephone status (**check at least one**) consistent with the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (SEC 3 [47 USC § 153(44)]).

Section 3 [47 USC § 153(44)] states that the term "rural telephone company" means a local exchange carrier operating to the extent that such entity:

- ☐ (A) provides common carrier service to any local exchange carrier study area that does not include either –
- (i) any incorporated place of 10,000 inhabitants or more, or any part thereof, based on the most recently available population statistics of the Bureau of the Census; or
 - (ii) any territory, incorporated or unincorporated, included in an urbanized area, as defined by the Bureau of Census as of August 10, 1993;
- ☐ (B) provides telephone exchange service, including exchange access, to fewer than 50,000 access lines;
- ☐ (C) provides telephone exchange service to any local exchange carrier study area with fewer than 100,000 access
- ☐ (D) has less than 15 percent of its access lines in communities of more than 50,000 on the date of enactment of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

If the carrier checks any letter other than "B" or "C" above, it must attach supporting documentation to this application demonstrating how it meets the criteria delineated in either "A" or "D."

Exhibit A
5 Year Plan

LTD Broadband (“LTD”) has been provisionally assigned support from the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund to deliver broadband to 4766 eligible service locations. These service locations exist inside 334 Census Block Groups (“CBG”)s in Ohio. LTD was founded to address the need for rural broadband access and, with additional funding through RDOF, will continue to fill this need. RDOF funding awards require construction to be completed beyond the five year time frame requested, however, LTD anticipates completing its RDOF construction well before the FCC RDOF ten year timeline dictates. LTD notes that the FCC has waived the 5 year planning requirement for RDOF awards. PUCO is following the FCC's waiver.

Exhibit B

Emergency Situation Functionality

LTD Broadband ("LTD") will provision service with sufficient back-up power to remain functional without an external power source in emergency situations. LTD is able to re-route traffic around damaged facilities and will be able to manage traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations. Applicant uses battery back-up power in the field and battery backup power at its NOC for broadband internet service.

LTD's VoIP service requires an Internet Protocol (IP) connection to the Company's network or public Internet and 120VAC power to function. In the event of a failure of the IP connection or the local AC power, the service, including the E911 feature, will not function. Upon activation of a customer, LTD will provide the customer with a notification containing clear instructions on the use of emergency services.

LTD's VoIP service is not specifically used as a nomadic device. Customers can, through mobile applications, move the device to different locations. The end users registered service address is the only location at which the subscriber is authorized to use the service. The service will work if the device is moved to another location within the US and connected to a public internet connection; however, this is only authorized when the subscriber updates their service address prior to using the service at the new location by calling the Company's customer service number 507 369-2669.

LTD's service includes enhanced 911 services (E911). When service is initially provisioned, and any time the subscriber's service address is updated, the service location is automatically transmitted to a third party E911 provider who geocodes the address, associates it with a local Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), provides an electronic positive affirmation that the address was properly geocoded, and stores the record on our behalf. When a subscriber dials 911, the call is routed to the third party 911 provider and then from there to the local PSAP. The location information is transmitted in the call signaling to the local PSAP, and is visible to the operator in E911 enabled PSAPs. In jurisdictions where an E911 service fee is imposed on Interconnected VoIP Services by law, the fee is passed through to the end user and remitted to the local authority in accordance with applicable policy.

Exhibit C
Public Interest Standard

Designation of LTD Broadband ("LTD") as an ETC will serve the public interest by facilitating the FCC's goal of developing voice and broadband networks in rural, high-cost areas. Under the 1996 Act, "upon request and consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity" the Commission shall "designate more than one common carrier as an eligible telecommunications carrier for a service area designated" by the Commission. Before such a designation, the Commission shall find that the designation is in the public interest. In its 2005 ETC Order, the FCC determined that the benefits of increased consumer choice, and the unique advantages of the applicant's service offering are components of a public interest analysis.

Expedited designation of LTD will serve the public interest by ensuring that the company is eligible to receive federal USF support, including through the FCC's high-cost programs. LTD will use this funding to directly advance the FCC's goal of deploying voice and broadband-capable networks in rural, high-cost areas while ensuring that rural consumers and anchor institutions benefit from innovations in communications technology. In particular, LTD will use federal USF support to expand access to high-speed, high-quality broadband and voice provided through interconnected VoIP and fiber optic networks for residents of rural Ohio. These advanced communications services will provide important connectivity to consumers, businesses, and community anchor institutions, including rural schools, libraries and medical facilities and are a unique alternative to services provided by traditional wireline carriers within the Company's designated service area.

Designation of LTD as an ETC is also in the public interest because it will promote increased competitive choice, thereby increasing innovation and incenting other carriers to improve their existing networks in order to remain competitive. This will result in greater access to high-speed broadband and voice services, as well as improved service quality for residents of underserved communities in RDOF-eligible areas of Ohio. LTD's services will provide consumers with additional choices in communications service providers, as well as a variety of service offerings at competitive rates.

4. LTD has not begun deploying fiber optics in Ohio yet. These deployments are in its current service territory.

5. Broadband pricing will vary depending on an urban rate survey. For example, in 2021, the price for 1 Gbps upload/500 Mbps upload is \$133.52. LTD's rates will not exceed the FCC benchmark rates.

A VoIP mobile phone app will be available at LTD's cost from the developer- \$10/month.

LTD is developing a Lifeline landing page for its website. It will contain the following terms and conditions in addition to a sign-up page to determine eligibility.

The Lifeline Service Program ("Lifeline") is a federally funded program established to provide monthly assistance to low-income households. The program is available to qualified low-income consumers and provides a discount on the qualified customer's monthly service.

To participate in the program, customer's must either have an income that is at or below 135% of the federal Poverty Guidelines, or participate in certain assistance programs. You can see if you are eligible with the Lifeline Eligibility Pre-Screening Tool on the Universal Service Administrative website at www.lifelinesupport.org.

I. Lifeline Program

a. Qualified LTD Broadband customers may receive a Lifeline discount on their voice service, broadband service, or as part of a bundled voice and broadband package. Terms and conditions of service are located at: <http://www.ltdbroadband.com/legal>. Once an application has been processed and accepted, a qualified Lifeline customer will have the Lifeline subsidy applied to their selected service.

b. The Federal credit amount provided to qualified Lifeline subscribers will be the maximum amount authorized by the FCC.

c. FCC rules prohibit more than one Lifeline service per household. The definition of a "household" is anyone living at an address (including children, relatives, people not related to the account holder, etc.) who share income(s) and household expenses. A household is not permitted to receive lifeline benefits from multiple providers.

II. Eligibility

a. To qualify for Lifeline service, a subscriber must meet certain state and federal eligibility requirements. These requirements are determined by the state in which the customer resides. These state and federal eligibility requirements include program-based eligibility or income-based eligibility.

III. Application

i. Are eligible for and currently receive benefits from the public assistance program(s) identified in the application form, or that they have income at or below the designated poverty level.

- ii. Do not currently receive Lifeline support serving their household and no other resident in their household participates in the Lifeline program.
- iii. Have reviewed the information contained in their application and it is true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief, and that they understand that providing false or fraudulent information to obtain Lifeline benefits is punishable by law.
- b. If a subscriber is applying based on state or federal program-based eligibility, they will be required to provide a copy of a document or program card showing proof of their participation in the qualifying program (Section II. b. Program Based Eligibility). This document or card must include the participant's name, address, program name and effective date of the award. For example, if you are eligible for the Lifeline program because you participate in the Medicaid program, you will need to submit a copy of your Medicaid benefit card with your application.
- c. If a subscriber is applying based on their household income being at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, they must provide LTD Broadband with income documentation. Acceptable documentation includes: current income statement from an employer; prior year's federal income tax return; a Social Security statement of benefits; a Veterans Administration statement of benefits; a retirement or pension statement of benefits; an Unemployment or Workers' Compensation statement of benefits; a federal notice letter of participation in General Assistance; a divorce decree; a child support award; or other official document containing income information.
- d. A customer's application for Lifeline services will be evaluated by LTD Broadband and/or any applicable state or federal agencies to confirm and verify the customer's eligibility to receive the Lifeline support. Once approved, the Lifeline subsidy shall be applied to the customer's account on the first billing cycle after their acceptance into the program. No refunds will be provided for charges prior to enrollment and approval of the program.
- e. The Lifeline program is administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") and in some states by state agencies. By applying for Lifeline services, a subscriber consents and agrees to the disclosure of any and all information submitted by the subscriber to USAC, USAC's agents, the National Lifeline Accountability Database and/or applicable state agencies to ensure the proper administration of the Lifeline program, and failure to provide such consent will result in the subscriber being denied the Lifeline service.

- c. Nontransferable and Non-assignable. Eligibility for LTD Broadband Lifeline services is personal and relates to the subscriber individually. Lifeline customers may not transfer to any third party, including a third party that is eligible for Lifeline services, any of the customer's rights or benefits received under the Lifeline services.
- d. Changes to Eligibility. A qualified customer receiving Lifeline services must notify LTD Broadband by submitting a Lifeline Change Notification/Request Form (available on our web site at: <https://www.inxwireless.com>) within 30 days if they no longer qualify for any of the public assistance programs identified in their application form, no longer meet the criteria for income

eligibility, if another member of their household receives Lifeline benefits, or if they no longer qualify for Lifeline services for any other reason. Once a customer informs LTD Broadband that they are no longer eligible for Lifeline services, LTD Broadband shall unenroll the customer for Lifeline services and discontinue the customer's Lifeline discount as of the first billing cycle following the effective date of the loss of benefits.

e. Change of Address. A qualified customer receiving Lifeline services must notify LTD Broadband by submitting a Lifeline Change Notification/Request Form (available on our web site at:

<https://www.ltdbroadband.com/legal>) within 30 days of any change of address. Continued service by LTD Broadband upon a change of service address is subject to availability of service at the new address and continued receipt of the Lifeline subsidy from LTD Broadband is subject to the location of the new service address. A change of service address that is not serviceable by LTD Broadband may be subject to an early termination fee upon disconnect.

f. Annual Recertification. LTD Broadband customers receiving Lifeline services must certify annually that 1) they are still eligible to receive the Lifeline subsidy and 2) no one else in the household is receiving Lifeline services. If the re-certification process is not completed prior to the expiration of the one-year anniversary of the last approved certification they will lose their Lifeline discount.

g. Unenrollment. If LTD Broadband determines during the re-certification process, or at any other time, that a customer fails to continue to qualify for Lifeline services, such customer will immediately be deemed ineligible to participate in the Lifeline service and will be unenrolled from the Lifeline service. If a qualified customer fails to complete their recertification by the deadline, they will be unenrolled from Lifeline service. A customer may choose to voluntarily unenroll from the Lifeline service at any time by submitting a Lifeline Change Notification/Request Form (available on our web site at: <https://www.inxwireless.com/legal>) Upon unenrollment from the Lifeline program for any reason, the customer shall no longer receive the Lifeline discount as of the first billing cycle following the effective date of their unenrollment. Unenrollment from Lifeline Services for any reason will not terminate a customer's service with LTD Broadband and termination of a customer's LTD Broadband internet service may be subject to an early termination fee.

h. Right to Terminate Service. LTD Broadband reserves the right to cancel the enrollment of any customer and/or permanently deactivate any customer's service for fraud, misrepresentation or other misconduct as determined solely by the Company. Customer agrees LTD Broadband's service will not be used for any other purpose that is not allowed by this agreement, the terms and conditions of LTD Broadband's voice service, or that is illegal. LTD Broadband can, without notice, limit, suspend or end a customer's service and unenroll a customer from Lifeline services for violating this provision or for any other good cause

A new registration must be obtained if the business is sold or if the form of ownership changes. An ownership change includes, but is not limited to, incorporating a business, changing from a partnership to a sole proprietor, a sole proprietorship to a partnership, or any similar entity change.

Vendor's Guide to Ohio Sales and Use Tax

What Is Sales Tax?

Sales tax is a "trust" tax that must be collected on taxable retail sales to Ohio customers by all Ohio retailers and those out-of-state retailers that are registered with Ohio. It is called a "trust" tax because the consumer has entrusted this tax to retailers with the understanding that it will be reported and paid to the state of Ohio in a timely manner.

Types of Vendors' Licenses

To apply for any of the license types listed below, please visit the Ohio Business Gateway (OBG) at gateway.ohio.gov or for a paper application, the Ohio Department of Taxation's (ODT) Web site at tax.ohio.gov.

Regular County Vendor's License – This type of license is required by vendors making sales from a fixed place of business and vendors that make sales online or by catalog. Vendors of tangible personal property and certain services must have one regular vendor's license for each sales location. The application form is ST 1. Services requiring a regular vendor's license are as follows:

- Fabrication, installation, repair and/or storage of tangible personal property.
- Hotel or similar room rentals.
- Laundry and dry cleaning (excludes coin-operated machine sales).
- Personal care services, including skin care, application of cosmetics, manicures, pedicures, hair removal, tattoos, body piercing, tanning, massage and other similar services. It does not include hair care, cutting, coloring or style. **Note:** If no fixed place of business, these services require a transient vendor's license.
- Physical fitness facility service (membership fees and sales of tangible personal property).
- Recreation and sports club service (membership fees and sales of tangible personal property).
- Towing of motor vehicles, including those wrecked, disabled, or illegally parked.
- Washing (except coin-operated), cleaning, waxing, polishing or painting of motor vehicles.
- Transportation of persons within Ohio (except by public transit systems or commercial airlines).
- Landscaping, lawn care & snow removal services
- Building maintenance & janitorial services

Note: Services are taxed at the location where the customer receives the benefit or makes first use of the service.

Transient Vendor's License – This type of license is required when making sales from a non-fixed location such as a fair, an exhibition or a trade show, when the vendor travels to the customer's location to sell taxable items. These licenses are valid throughout Ohio and allow a vendor to make sales in all 88 counties in Ohio. The application form is ST 1T.

Filing Requirements

The Universal Sales Tax return (UST1) is used for all of the above licenses and must be electronically filed and paid by the due date. The filing frequency is determined by the ODT. Your frequency is stated on the Registration Confirmation notice and you will be informed in writing of any filing frequency changes.

Monthly Filers – The UST1 must be electronically filed and paid by the 23rd day of the month following the reporting period, for all tax collected during the preceding month. If the 23rd is on a weekend or holiday, the due date is the next business day.

Semi-annual Filers – Vendors and sellers whose tax liability is less than \$1,200 per six-month period may file and pay their sales taxes semi-annually. Such returns are due by the 23rd day of the month following the close of each semi-annual period for the tax collected during the preceding six-month period.

- Jan. 1 through June 30 – return and payment are due on or before July 23rd.
- July 1 through Dec. 31 – return and payment are due on or before Jan. 23rd.

Returns must still be filed even if no sales are made or no tax is due. Failing to file a return or remit tax due will result in fines, penalties and possibly criminal charges.

Ohio Tax Alerts – Vendors may sign up to receive tax alerts via e-mail for multiple tax types, including sales and use tax. These alerts include reminders of when semi-annual and monthly universal sales tax (UST1) returns and payments are due. These reminders can assist vendors in remitting timely returns and payments. This can be a very helpful service, as the ODT does not mail returns or information to new or existing vendors. To use this service, simply sign-up from our Web site at tax.ohio.gov.

Mandatory Electronic Filing

Each person holding a vendor's license, regardless of sales volume, is required to file a UST1 return electronically. ODT offers two ways to file a sales tax return electronically.

The Ohio Business Gateway – OBG allows taxpayers to electronically file their UST1 return and accepts electronic checks and credit cards for online payment and also allows taxpayers the option to pay with a paper check. To use this option, please visit gateway.ohio.gov and click on the "Login Now" or "Create an Account" link on the OBG home page.

TeleFile – Vendors with a regular (single) county vendor's license beginning with 01-88 may electronically file their UST1 returns over the phone through Ohio's TeleFile system. TeleFile users can remit payment by electronic check or credit card. To utilize the Ohio Telefile system, a vendor must have their vendor's license number and their two-digit TIN available. This information can be found on the Registration Confirmation issued when their vendor's license was activated. To use this option please call 1-800-697-0440.

Canceling a Vendor's License

If a vendor stops making taxable retail sales, a final UST1 must be filed and all taxes must be paid within 15 days of the final sale. Vendors must complete the space provided on the final UST1 indicating the last day of business. All electronic filing options, including OBG and TeleFile, allow a vendor to cancel their vendor's license when filing their final UST1. If you are a liquor permit holder, you cannot cancel the vendor's license until action has been taken on the liquor permit.

Are Vendors' Licenses Transferable?

Any change in ownership (sole proprietor to partnership, partnership to corporation, corporation to sole proprietor, partnership to sole proprietor, etc.) that requires the issuance of a new Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) requires a new license. A final UST1 return must be filed and all taxes paid within 15 days of the last day of business. Any change in location of a fixed place of business for a regular county vendor's license (beginning with 01-88) not within the same county, or if there is also a liquor permit, even within the same county, requires a new license, and a final UST1 return must be filed within 15 days of the last day of business for the preceding license. A change in location of a fixed place of business for a regular county vendor's license within the same county does not require a new license. However, you are required to complete form ST3 TL – Request for Transfer of Vendor's License. A change in the mailing address does not require a new license and can be requested by completing a ST 3C and can be found on ODT's Web site at tax.ohio.gov.

Determining Sales Tax Rates

Please visit the ODT Web site (tax.ohio.gov) or call the Business Taxpayer Services line (1-888-405-4039) for information on the tax rates and rules governing Ohio's sales and use tax. Sign up for Ohio Tax Alert and receive notification of tax rate changes. Sales and use tax rates for any address in Ohio can be verified by using The Finder, an online resource available at tax.ohio.gov.

Important Notes for Sales Tax

Nonprofit organizations exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code that make retail sales no more than six days a year are not required to have a vendor's license or collect tax on those sales. If sales occur on more than six days, the organization must obtain a license and charge and remit tax. School-related, parent-teacher, and booster groups are exempt from registering and collecting the tax.

Sales Tax Exemptions – Blanket Exemption Certificate

(STEC B) – is used to purchase items exempt from sales tax with a valid reason for exemption (resale, agriculture, manufacturing, nonprofit, etc). The exemption form can be obtained from ODT's Web site at tax.ohio.gov. Promoters, organizers or owners of trade shows, fairs, flea markets, exhibitions or similar events where transient vendors make retail sales are required to maintain for at least four years and make available to the ODT records of the vendor's names, addresses, vendor's license numbers and types of goods sold.

What Is Use Tax?

Use tax is a tax on the storage, use or other consumption of tangible personal property and certain taxable services in Ohio. These include purchases made from both Ohio and out-of-state vendors. The tax is a complement to the Ohio sales tax. In general, if you have paid Ohio sales tax on purchases of certain items or certain taxable services, then you do not owe Ohio use tax. If you have not paid Ohio sales tax, then you have a responsibility to remit Ohio use tax directly to the ODT, unless there is an exception or exemption that applies to the transaction. Please refer to the ODT's Web site (tax.ohio.gov) for more information on what is subject to use tax and the appropriate sales/use tax rate for your county. Sales and use tax rates for any address in Ohio can be verified by using The Finder, an online resource available at tax.ohio.gov.

How Do I Remit Use Tax Directly to Ohio?

The Universal Use Tax return (UUT1) is used for filing use tax. Businesses need to register for a Consumer's Use Tax account to begin remitting use tax directly to Ohio. Registration and filing are available on OBG at gateway.ohio.gov. OBG accepts electronic checks and credit cards for online payment and also allows taxpayers the option to print a payment coupon to pay with a paper check.

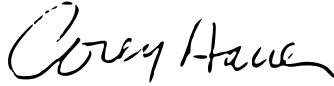

Decisions and Use of this Software and Website

Except as otherwise expressly provided in this agreement, all decisions relating to the management of the LLC will require the unanimous consent of the members of the LLC.

Except as set out below, all decisions and other actions to be taken by the members will be done through the medium of this website in accordance with its procedures for proposing and acting upon a decision.

We will not use the Nevada flume website as the sole communications method for members. Notifications will also be via email.

Should the Nevada Secretary of State digital operating agreement website become temporarily or permanently dysfunctional or unavailable to one or more of the members, then other means of communication authorized under Nevada Law will be permitted for use by the members to take actions until the website shall again become functional and available to all members, and the latest recorded version of the Operating Agreement shall be the Members' operating agreement.

Final Form of Operating Agreement

The members agree that the version available on this website will be the version of the operating agreement that will be relied upon by all members and managers as the final, binding expression of their operating agreement. The Nevada Secretary of State does not accept responsibility for any failure to maintain this website.

Withdrawal and Transfer of Interest

A member may withdraw from the LLC only with the unanimous approval of the other members.

Voluntary Withdrawal

An existing member may propose a voluntary withdrawal from the LLC, which requires the approval of all of the other existing members to be effective.

A Voluntary Withdrawal will constitute a surrender of the interest back to the LLC.

Involuntary withdrawal (expulsion)

Any member of the LLC may propose the involuntary removal of another member. The proposal should describe the reasons for the proposal, including the specific lapses of the member whose removal is proposed. As with other decisions, the members, including the member whose removal is proposed, will have the opportunity to exchange their views on the matter and to vote on the removal. Because of the nature of this proposal, the requirement for unanimity will not include the member whose removal is being considered, and such person will not have a vote on this matter. This procedure is not available if the LLC has fewer than three members. If, within 30 days the proposal is accepted by all of the members other than the member in question, the member whose removal has been approved will cease to be a member of the LLC.

In the event of an involuntary withdrawal, the withdrawing member shall be entitled to the fair market value of the withdrawing member's membership interest, less any debt owed by such member to the LLC, paid by the LLC within 30 days after the notice to the member.

Transfer of Interest Through Sale

Transfer of the interest can also be made by a sale of the interest, either to a current member or to a potential new member.

Information about that proposed transfer will be provided to all of the members by the proposer, along with the terms of the transfer. The share of the transferring member will be allocated to the person(s) acquiring the membership interest. Once the proposed terms are set out, the decision whether or not to approve the transfer will be circulated for comment and decision.

If the proposal calls for a transfer to a new member and it is approved, then the new member will be invited to join, by signing up for the Nevada LLC Digital Operating Agreement service, and by accepting the invitation and the terms approved by the members. Once accepted, the new member becomes a "substituted member" and will have all of the rights, powers, restrictions, and liabilities of the transferor.

If the transfer to a new member and has not been approved, then the transferee has no right to participate in the management or affairs of the company and is only entitled to receive the transferor's share of profits, compensation, or return of contributions. The transferor in this case is not released from any liability to the company.

Death or Disability of a Member

The members agree that there will be an automatic repurchase of a member's interest on the following terms when that member suffers death or disability:

The member whose death, disability or bankruptcy has been approved will cease to be a member of the LLC. The personal representative of the deceased or disabled member shall be entitled to receive a payment,

in a reasonable time, from the LLC in an amount equal to the fair market value of his/her interest, less any damages caused to the business of the LLC by failures of such member to make agreed contributions of money, property, or services or by some other breach of duties to the LLC. The shares of the profit and loss of the member being bought out will be allocated among the remaining members in proportion to their then current membership interests.

Amendments to the Operating Agreement or to the Articles of Organization

A member may propose an amendment to the Operating Agreement or to the Articles of Organization, which will require unanimous approval of the members to take effect. An agreement through this medium to change the Articles only authorizes the amendment to the Articles to be filed with the agreed change. The Amendment to the Articles of Organization will still need to be filed with the Secretary of State's office to become effective.

Distributions

No member or transferee of a member's interest has a right to demand or receive a distribution in any form other than cash, without the approval of a majority of the members.

Indemnification

Although the statute allows the Operating Agreement to specify the terms under which a decision is made to indemnify a member, manager, employee or agent, this Digital format allows such a decision to be made only by a unanimous vote of the members, not including a member to be indemnified. Likewise, the decision to advance the payments or pay the expenses as incurred related to the indemnification will be made in the same manner.

Member's Right to Obtain and Manager's Right to Examine Records

All members have a right to obtain and copy records of the LLC upon reasonable request, during normal business hours, at the requesting member's expense.

Approval of Interested Transactions

Any transaction between a member or members and the LLC is prohibited unless a decision is approved by all of the disinterested Members after full disclosure of all material facts.

Authority to Deal with Third Parties

Each of the members of the LLC will have full authority to act on behalf of the LLC, and to bind it legally, in its dealings with all third parties.

Dissolution and Winding Up

The death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, dissolution or disassociation of a member does not itself cause the dissolution and wind-up of the LLC. Any member may propose the dissolution of the company in accordance with the following process:

The proposal shall set forth reasons for the proposed dissolution and shall assign responsibility for carrying out 5 important steps in a successful dissolution: i) marshaling and sale or disposition of assets; ii) payment of creditors; iii) filing of final tax returns and other compliance documents; iv) distribution of remaining assets to members; and v) filing the Articles of Dissolution. It shall also set out any additional compensation to be paid to the person carrying out one or more of these steps.

The approval of all members will be necessary in order for the dissolution and winding up to go forward.

Actions by Written Consent

The members and managers may take any action requiring a meeting by written consent signed by the proportion of membership interest required to take the action.

Waiver of Notice

Any notice required by statute, the Articles of Organization, or the Operating Agreement to be given to a member or manager may be waived if a written waiver is signed by the person or persons to be notified, whether before or after the time stated in the notice.

Operating Agreement Bound by Nevada Statutes

This entire operating agreement is governed by and subject to the provisions of Nevada Law, and to the extent no modification has been made by this operating agreement, the underlying provisions of Nevada Law governing LLCs will apply to the management and internal affairs of the LLC.
