Thousands of agricultural acres are being lost. The beauty of our community is dimming. Investors have purchased hundreds of acres merely to lease the profit of a few. They have no concern for others or the agricultural community. Few investors live in the area. They are here merely to line their pockets at our expense. A few profit, the majority lose.

These Solar Farms are a hideous site. Fenced in areas with razor wire. Poor drainage, so fields of mud. County roadways unable to handle the traffic or heavy machinery. Unknown and untested health issues. EMF radiation exposed to my grandchildren. Most of the residents have drilled wells. What happens to the water supply? How safe will the water be? What pollutants will we find? What happens to our property values we have worked so hard to establish? How will this affect remaining agricultural land? How will temperature changes alter the environment? What happens to the wildlife we cherish? I believe that our environment, our ecology, our health, and the beauty of our land will be destroyed. Will fracking be a part of this project?

I want my community to maintain its rich heritage in agriculture, not solar panels. I want to see ALL profit, not a selfish FEW.
