{¶ 1} Pursuant to the attorney examiner Entry of May 28, 2014, all eligible telecommunications carriers were directed to file a copy in this docket of the annual report filed with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 54.313(j).

{¶ 2} Beginning on June 20, 2014, through August 15, 2014, ETCs filed information consistent with the Entry of May 28, 2014. The following responding companies submitted redacted information accompanied by a motion for protective treatment: CenturyTel of Ohio dba CenturyLink and United Telephone of Ohio dba CenturyLink (collectively CenturyLink); Ottoville Mutual Telephone Company; Sherwood Mutual Telephone Association, Inc.; Arthur Mutual Telephone Company; Benton Ridge Telephone Company; Champaign Telephone Company; Ayersville Telephone Company; Vanlue Telephone Company; Kalida Telephone Company Inc.; Continental Telephone of Ohio; Little Miami Communications; Arcadia Telephone Company; Oakwood Telephone Company; Windstream Ohio, Inc. and Windstream Western Reserve, Inc. (collectively, Windstream); Bascom Mutual Telephone Company; Vaughnsville Telephone Company; Chillicothe Telephone Company; Orwell Telephone Company; Columbus Grove Telephone Company; Germantown Independent Telephone Company; Farmers Mutual Telephone Company; Fort Jennings Telephone Company; Wabash Mutual Telephone Company; Ridgeville Telephone Company; Glandorf Telephone Company; Sycamore Telephone Company; McClure Telephone Company; Buckland Telephone Company; T-Mobile Central LLC and Voice Stream Pittsburgh Limited Partnership (collectively, T-Mobile); Frontier Communications of Michigan, Inc., and Frontier North Inc. (collectively, Frontier); Middle Point Home Telephone Company; Conneaut Telephone Company; Minford Telephone

Company; Telephone Service Company; Nova Telephone Company; Pattersonville Telephone Company; and New Knoxville Telephone Company.

{¶ 3} Pursuant to the Entry of August 26, 2016, protective treatment was granted for the information filed under seal for a period of 24 months.

{¶ 4} On July 10, 2018, Middle Point filed a motion for extension of the previously granted protective treatment. Pursuant to the Entry of September 12, 2018, the motion for an extension was granted until August 26, 2020.

{¶ 5} A review of the record in this matter reflects that the grant of the 24 month extension has now expired and that none of the affected companies in this docket have filed to seek an extension of the previously granted protective treatment. Accordingly, absent the filing of such requests, the docketing division is directed to release, seven days from the date of this Entry, all information currently filed under seal in this docket.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the information filed under seal in this docket be released to the public seven days from the date of this Entry consistent with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
