United States Fish and Wildlife Service Letter

Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio), filed a Construction Notice, pursuant to O.A.C. Chapter 4906-6, on April 22, 2021, concerning a proposed project known as the Miami Fort Gas Turbine Generation Substation Separation Project. The Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) Staff issued its report recommending automatic approval of the project on May 14, 2021, provided that, among others, the following condition was satisfied:

(3) The Applicant shall adhere to seasonal cutting dates of October 1 through March 31 for the removal of trees three inches or greater in diameter to avoid impacts to listed bat species, unless coordination with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service allows a different course of action. If coordination with these agencies allows clearing between April 1 and September 30, the Applicant shall docket proof of completed coordination on the case docket prior to clearing trees.

Duke Energy Ohio is attaching herewith correspondence from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in accordance with Condition 3.

Therefore, this condition has been satisfied.
