

Dear Sir or Madam:

On 03/24/2021, a vehicle operated by ACE PYRO LLC, and driven by, ENZER, AARON A was inspected within the state of Ohio. As a result of discovery of the following violation(s) of the Commission's rules, Staff of the Commission timely notified AARON A ENZER pursuant to rule 4901:2-7-07, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), that it intended to assess a civil forfeiture against AARON A ENZER in the following amount:

A conference was conducted pursuant to Rule 4901:2-10, OAC, at which AARON A ENZER had a full opportunity to present reasons why the violation(s) did not occur as alleged, mitigating circumstances regarding the amount of any forfeiture, and any other information relevant to the action proposed to be taken by the Staff.



In addition, your Ohio operating authority and/or commercial driving privileges may be sanctioned as permitted by law.
