To the Honorable Commission:

In accordance with Section 4933.83(E), Revised Code, Butler Rural Electric Cooperative (Butler) and Duke Energy (Duke) filed a joint petition before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) to reallocate a portion of their electric certified territories. The reallocation is intended to allow for Butler Rural Electric to provide power to a pump house facility. The cost for Duke to provide this service is approximately \$25,000, while Rural can provide service from the North for approximately \$11,000. Butler's service will be approximately 600 ft primary underground, 200 ft primary overhead and 150 ft secondary underground. The proposed boundary change is illustrated in the attached map.

Staff of the Commission (Staff) reviewed the petition for conformance with R.C. 4933.81 to 4933.90. The petitioning electric suppliers and all affected customers are in agreement with the proposed reallocation. Absent any objections from the Commission or other parties, Staff recommends approval of the proposed reallocation of electric certified territory.


