Dear Ms. Troupe:

On March 15, 2021, Guernsey Power Station LLC (“GPS”) filed a third amendment application to amend its certificate granted in Case No. 16-2443-EL-BGN to construct and operate a 1,650 MW electric generating facility. The amendment would allow the use of two adjoining parcels recently acquired by GPS, for the purpose of temporary workspace.

On June 9, 2021, the Ohio Power Siting Board (“OPSB” or “Board”) Staff filed its Report of Investigation. In the report, the OPSB Staff recommends approval of the amendment application, subject to certain conditions.

This letter is to confirm for the Board and administrative law judge that GPS does not object to the conditions proposed in the Staff Report. In addition, GPS respectfully requests that the administrative law judge and Board place this application on the Board agenda for a decision at the soonest possible Board meeting. There are currently over 750 construction workers at the project site, and the additional parcels are needed to help with COVID-19 distancing considerations and other temporary uses.
