{¶ 1} On April 27, 2021, the above-captioned application was filed pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(D) for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility as defined in R.C. 4928.01.

{¶ 2} By Entry filed on May 6, 2021, the attorney examiner suspended the automated approval process in this case pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(D), which provides that upon good cause show, the Commission may suspend the certification of an application to allow the Commission and its Staff to further review the application.

{¶ 3} On May 7, 2021, Carbon Solutions Group, LLC filed a motion to intervene, motion to consolidate, and motion to establish a procedural schedule, along with a memorandum in support of the motions.

{¶ 4} At this time, the attorney examiner schedules a telephonic prehearing conference on July 22, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern time. At the designated time of the conference, the parties shall dial 614-721-2972 and enter access code 439 902 211# to join the conference. The attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues including possible stipulations of fact and potential hearing dates.

{¶ 5} Any party wishing to intervene in this matter should file a motion for intervention by July 15, 2021.

{¶ 6} Additionally, Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-08(A) requires that corporations or other business entities be represented by an attorney-at-law at proceedings in front of the Commission. Therefore, any corporation or other business entity in this proceeding will be

required to be represented by legal counsel for all further proceedings in this case, including the prehearing conference.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a prehearing conference be scheduled in accordance with Paragraph 4. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That any motions to intervene in this proceeding must be filed in accordance with Paragraphs 5 and 6. It is, further,

{¶ 10} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
