Dear Examiners:

Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) would like to update the Commission regarding matters affecting this docket. In this case, the Company supported continuation of the Direct Load Control (DLC) experimental tariff program. In a recent settlement in Case Nos. 20-585-EL-AIR et al., the Company agreed as part of a settlement package to eliminate its DLC tariff upon approval of the Stipulation. (20-585 Case, March 12, 2021 Joint Stipulation and Recommendation at Paragraph III.E.15.) Accordingly, the Company does not object to either: (1) a decision in this case that terminates of the DLC tariff subject to the Stipulation being adopted by the Commission in the 20-585 Case, or (2) a decision in this case that defers the DLC issue to the 20-585 Case.
