{¶ 1} On May 20, 2021, XOOM Energy Ohio, LLC filed an application to renew its certification as a competitive retail electric service provider in Ohio.

{¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that an application for certification renewal shall be deemed automatically approved pursuant to R.C. 4928.08, upon the 31st day after the filing date. Also, Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A)(1) provides that, upon good cause shown, an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of an application.
