
## Notice of Public Information Meeting for Proposed Major Utility Facility

South Branch Solar, LLC schedules public information meeting for June 24, 2021 to outline plans for an up to 205 megawatt ("MW") solar-powered electric facility in Washington Township, Hancock County, Ohio.

South Branch Solar, LLC ("South Branch") invites residents and other interested members of the public to participate in the public informational meeting to outline plans to build the South Branch Solar Project in Washington Township, Hancock County, Ohio.

South Branch is proposing to develop, construct, and operate an up to 205 MW solar-powered electric facility in Washington Township, Hancock County, Ohio. The general purpose of the project is to maximize energy production from solar resources in order to deliver clean, renewable electricity to the regional transmission system to serve the needs of electric utilities and their customers. South Branch expects to file its application in July 2021. Construction of the project is planned to begin in the fourth quarter of 2022, with commercial operation in 2023.

South Branch has arranged for a public community meeting to be held on Thursday, June 24, 2021 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Arcadia Lions Community Center located at 301 W Brown Road, Arcadia, Ohio 44804. The meeting format will be similar to an open house. Maps of the project area will be available to review. Company representatives will also be available to answer questions. Those who attend the meeting may write comments that South Branch will summarize and include in its application.
