Pursuant to the June 7, 2021 Entry in the above-referenced matter, The New Knoxville Telephone Company seeks to modify its Access Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 1 in accordance with FCC 8YY Access Charge Reform Order, DA 20-143.

The proposed tariff revisions restructure the transport rates for toll-free services to mirror its interstate joint tandem transport rates and to confirm that its toll-free originating end office rates will be set at the lesser of interstate or intrastate rates in compliance with the FCC 8YY Access Charge Reform Order.
