I, Paul E. Fish and my wife, Sandra L. Fish are currently customers of Dominion Energy. This complaint is against Dominion Energy, regarding the usurpation of property owners' rights not only as property owners but as citizens of Ohio and the United States.

<u>Fact one.</u> There is no law, governmental mandate, or legal requirement for anybody to obscure their physical identity for any reason.

<u>Fact two.</u> A company's policy is not law, it is not enforceable by any law-enforcement agency, nor is it applicable to anybody outside of that company's real property, employ, or vehicles.

<u>Fact three.</u> A safety requirement from a private property owner regarding not only the safety of their real property, but also regarding the safety of all inhabitants of the property, their belongings, valuables and fixtures, <u>is not a prohibition to entry</u>.

<u>Fact four.</u> <u>Dominion energy employees have CHOSEN to not perform their prescribed</u> <u>duties</u> because the owners of the property at 429 Independence St. have legally asserted their right to safety and free exercise of Scriptural faith, according to their rights not only as property owners, but also as United States Citizens.

Fact five. Threatening to punish people who exercise their rights with utility shutoff, because they choose to exercise their rights, is a direct violation of TITLE 18, U.S.C., SECTION 242. One might argue that Dominion is not acting as law-enforcement, and is therefore not encumbered by this law, because they believe that they cannot act under the "color of law" but the wording of the law is very clear. "Whoever, under color of any law, statute, ordinance, regulation, or custom, willfully subjects any person in any State, Territory, Commonwealth, Possession, or District to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immunities secured or protected by the Constitution or laws of the United States, ... shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than one year, or both"

Notice is says "WHOEVER". Color of law is defined as such: "the appearance of an act being performed based upon legal right or enforcement of statute, when in reality no such right exists." A prime example would be claiming to have the right to usurp the rights of individuals' real estate, religious and other constitutional rights because the company has a "right to inspect their equipment". Yes, Dominion has a right to inspect their equipment, but that right is secondary to the rights of the citizens.

<u>Fact six.</u> The property at 429 Independence St. Fairport Harbor, Ohio, houses a Scripture-based ministry. This ministry is called "4YHVH Ministries", and applies Scriptural rules and laws to the household, according to the Torah and B'rit Khadasha.

2 Corinthians 3:14-18. ¹⁴ What is more, their minds were made stonelike; for to this day the same veil remains over them when they read the Old Covenant; it has not been unveiled, because only by the Messiah is the veil taken away. ¹⁵ Yes, till today, whenever Moshe is read, a veil lies over their heart. ¹⁶ "But," says the *Torah*, "whenever someone turns to YHVH, the veil is taken away." ¹⁷ Now, "YHVH" in this text means the Spirit. And where the Spirit of YHVH is, there is freedom. ¹⁸ So all of us, with faces unveiled, see as in a mirror the glory of the Moshiakh; and we are being changed into his very image, from one degree of glory to the next, by YHVH the Spirit.

Deuteronomy 31:12

Assemble the people — the men, the women, the little ones and <u>the foreigners</u> you have in your towns — so that they can hear, learn, fear *YHVH* your God and <u>take care to obey all the words</u> <u>of this *Torah*; (Anyone not of our faith is a foreigner)</u>

Outside of our property we have absolutely no authority to enforce our Faith based doctrines, but inside of our property we have every right. Putting booties on over your shoes in a mosque is not permitted, your shoes must be removed, and everybody who does not CHOOSE to comply with such a simple requirement, CHOOSES not to enter the mosque. It is no different than our home which is our sanctuary, our place of worship and which is governed by the laws of Scripture as well as the secular laws that protect our rights. So it is not only a security issue, it is also a faith based issue that faces cannot be obscured while upon our property.

<u>Fact seven.</u> We have stated time and again that if Dominion's technician wears a clear face shield, we have absolutely no restrictions against such personal protection. This is because our security cameras will have the opportunity to see the whole face of the stranger who is entering our home, and since it does not veil the face of the individual, it is in compliance with our faith based requirements. It also would not alarm our dogs, causing them to harm themselves. (We have decided to close the dogs up in the garage for the duration of the inspection in order to provide additional security for the dogs, and for the tech).

Fact eight. We have stated time and again that we also have no problem with any kind of distancing because distancing of any kind is not a violation of our rights or our faith, and is preferable to all parties involved. It has been conveyed to the many representatives of Dominion for the past two months of correspondence between us and them, that we have absolutely no problem with letting a tech into our home in order to inspect their equipment, and we have never denied anybody any access to our home and the meter. On June 4, their technician CHOSE NOT TO PERFORM HIS DUTIES when he was required to not obscure his identity. Nobody denied him entry; it was his CHOICE to leave.

<u>Fact nine.</u> We have stated numerous times that we will leave the front door open, provide a clear path to the meter, even post signs pointing to the meter's location, and not even be in the same room with the tech, expanding greatly, the six-foot theory, as long as his or her full face is visible through a clear plastic shield, even allowing them to wear a mask if they so choose while near the gas meter as they perform their inspection, only removing it while walking through our house, and they still claim that we "refuse to let their tech inspect the meter".

<u>Fact ten.</u> Dominion refuses to inspect their meter unless we agree to surrender all of our applicable rights to them, even though we have offered to accommodate them as much as we could possibly do, with more than reasonable compromises. Let me make this abundantly clear once again: WE HAVE NOT, NOR WILL WE EVER DENY ACCESS TO THE METER! We simply require Dominion to respect our rights as they access it.

What do we ask of the PUCO? We ask that the PUCO assert their authority as the governing body over utility companies such as Dominion energy, and to uphold the constitution of the United States of America, and to prohibit Dominion from cancellation of our service as a bully tactic designed to force us to surrender our rights, ESPECIALLY since they have REFUSED to perform their duties as prescribed to them, due to a mere company policy. A company policy that is not law, not enforceable by law, carries absolutely no legal weight or authority, but which is being used, unfairly, to attempt to strip us of our God Given Rights. In no court of law will any judge rule that a company's policy has authority over the natural rights of citizens.

Let it be known that all individuals who actively or passively aid and abet Dominion in their illegal attempt at usurping our rights, can possibly be held liable for any and all damages of any kind if their actions can be proven to be of assistance to Dominion in any way, shape, or form, from the smallest contribution to the largest contribution to their actions overall.
