To the Ohio Power Siting Board -

I am writing in support of the Pleasant Prairie solar project in Franklin County. I supported Columbus' choice to aggregate for clean electricity, which was on the ballot last year. Now Franklin County is in the process of planning which clean energy projects will be put in place. This proposed solar project will add to the grid enough energy to power 49,593 homes. The result is a decrease in emissions, the equivalent of taking 54,358 cars off the road. Since there are going to be many people moving to central Ohio in the next decade, these types of energy projects are vital. We cannot and should not rely on energy from fossil fuel alone - the emissions and carbon pollution would cost us much in health related costs, and put us behind in effort against climate change. This solar project is also a good economic decision for the region. The 1.75 million in tax revenue per year will benefit local public services and schools. Finally, I appreciate that many specific details and concerns have been addressed with this project, including having an anti-glare coating on the panels, complying with local fire codes, and designed for minimal environmental impact.
