

In addition, contracts for the procurement of gas will be between the energy supplier {the energy company providing the gas} and the energy user {the real estate owner}.

The company's role will be essentially that a broker, and it will attempt to match the needs of the many commercial real estate companies (with a particular emphasis on owners of shopping malls) with which it is familiar and through its other business channel has worked with over the last few decades with the largest energy suppliers in the nation.
