To whom it may concern,

I am filing this formal complaint because I believe I am being discriminated against by the assessment of fees for opting out of a smart meter at my home. I am also requesting that a smart meter not be installed at my neighbor's house, 6631 Wallings Rd, which would be very near my bedroom, and no fees be imposed for that opt-out as well. I have ongoing health issues which are exacerbated by exposure to electro-magnetic fields. I experience the following symptoms when in close proximity to an source of EMFs:

-heart palpatations
-headaches, particularly on the left side
-neuropathy (nerve issues and numbness)
-anxiety and irritability

We have gone to extreme measures to reduce my exposure to EMFs at our home. These measures include:

-not using WiFi
-hard-wiring all tv's and computers
-re-routing the electrical main so that it is further from the bedrooms
-minimizing use of cellphones and only using the speaker for making calls
-turning off the breakers every night to minimize EMFs during sleep

Other members of my household also have health issues (autoimmune conditions, ADHD, etc.) and we all see at doctor at the Functional Medicine department at the Cleveland Clinic. With her help, we are on a path for wellness and work very hard to stay off medication and heal the natural way - through healthy food and lifestyle. I truly believe that installation of a smart meter near our bedrooms would be detrimental to our health. Our doctor has advised me to avoid EMFs as they clearly worsen my issues.

I believe that imposing fees on those with ongoing health problems, whose health would be further compromised by installation of a smart-meter, is discriminatory and ask that you waive these fees.
