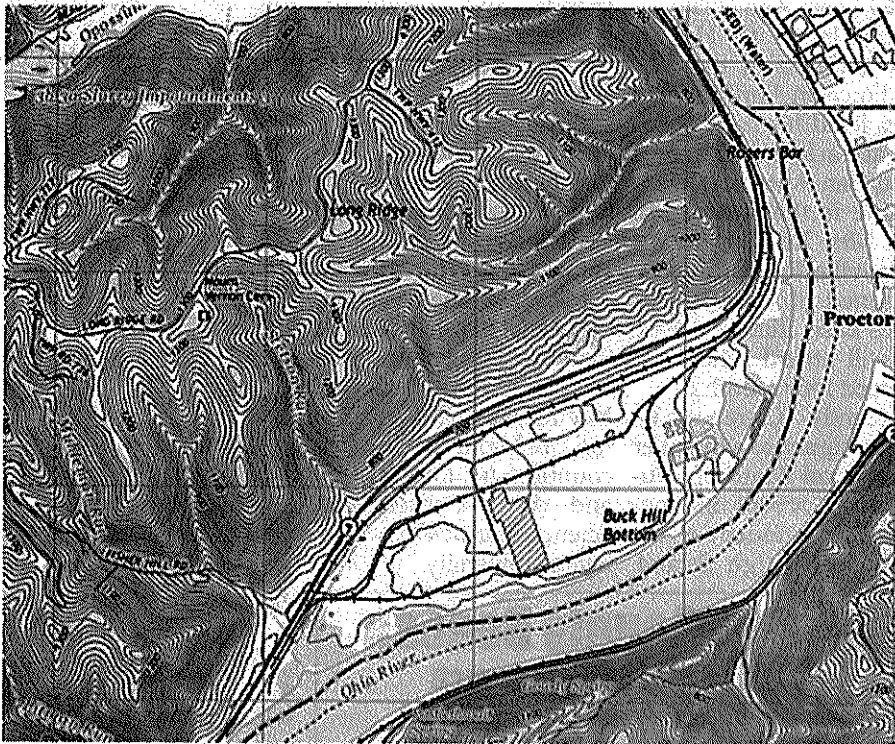

'We can't give it away'

Only 35.5 percent of Monroe County residents have started the vaccine. That number falls to 34.1 percent to have completed both doses. Woodsfield has the highest percentage of vaccinated residents at 42 percent. Other communities vary from 28 percent in Graysville to 39 percent in Lewisville.

Dixon and Monroe County Health Department Public Information Officer Amanda Sefert said the numbers are similar in southeastern Ohio and the rest of the state.

After an initial surge when vaccines started arriving in January and February, interest waned in the months that followed.

"We've known (there was little demand for vaccines) since around May," Sefert said. "We were having clinics on evenings and Saturdays for people who worked and very few were showing up."

"In January and February we (the Monroe County Health Department) were on lockdown," Dixon added, suggesting supply couldn't meet demand. "Now we can't give it (vaccines) away."

Monroe County Health Commissioner Linda Dick is concerned about what the lower rate of vaccinations could mean for the rest of the year.

"I have a lot of concerns," she said, "especially with a variant that is highly contagious." Dick wants residents to understand that all medications have some type of side effects, but that doesn't mean they are harmful.

"You have to weigh the positives with the negatives," Dick said. "I encourage everyone to get

the vaccine. I hope we can stop this thing (the COVID-19 virus)."

While the vaccine cannot prevent you from contracting the COVID-19 virus, it provides protection against the virus and significantly reduces the likelihood of hospitalization and death.

The Ohio Department of Health recently said that the vaccine can lower the chance of spreading the virus, even if you are symptomatic.

Dixon recognizes many in Monroe County don't trust the vaccine, but stressed that modern medicine is capable of quickly making a vaccine, especially when resources of made available to do so.

"It's part of medicine," Dixon said. "You vaccinate your kids, your pets, your animals and livestock."

The demand might not be there and it might not come, but the Monroe County Health Department will continue to try to save lives.

Two open clinics will be held in August at the Monroe County Health Department and a third will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 24 during the Monroe County Fair. The clinic will be held at the EMS pavilion at the Monroe County Fairgrounds.

Sefert and Dixon hope residents take advantage of the opportunity to get vaccinated. But whether they do or not, they feel they need to keep trying.

"We will continue to offer (the vaccine) and continue to put out information from ODH (the Ohio Department of Health) and CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention)," Sefert said.

What is the best way to prevent the spread of the virus, according to the Monroe County Health Department? Vaccination.

"The COVID-19 vaccines offer very high rates of protection against Delta hospitalization and death," the press release reads. "While there are potential side effects from the vaccination - just there are for any antibiotic or other medication - those risks are small compared to the risks of COVID-19 for people of any age."

Monroe County residents age 18 and older will have a few chances to get the Moderna vaccine during open clinics in August.

Clinics will be held from 9 to 11 a.m. and 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. Monday, Aug. 9 and Tuesday, Aug. 24 at the Monroe County Health Department on Home Avenue in Woodsfield.

There will also be a vac-

cination clinic from 5 to 7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 24 at the EMS Pavilion during the Monroe County Fair.

Appointments are not required.

The Monroe County Health Department hopes county residents take advantage of the vaccination clinics to help limit the spread of the virus in the next few months.

"With fall and cooler temperatures around the corner, it is even more important to get vaccinated," the press release reads. "Remember, it takes up to 6 weeks to be fully protected against COVID-19 from the beginning of the first dose received to complete protection."

Finding Susan's roots

or early 1960s. The home had an intricate parquet floor that, unfortunately, was lost to history.

More details followed, adding layers to Hughes' story. After coming in with very little information and an obituary she summarized as "old man dies," VanMeakins was getting to know her roots.

That trip through time was made possible through the work of Odgen, Schaber and the other members of the Monroe County Genealogical Society.

The group recently published its second book of Center Township cemeteries. The book is a compilation of all the people buried in nine cemeteries in Center Township, including Ayers, Cooper (also known as Kirkbride), Egger Ridge, Ford, Hope Ridge, Infirmary, Okey Farm, Potts and St. Sylvester.

In order to accumulate the information necessary for the books, the Monroe County Genealogical Society members spend months, and in some cases years, going over cemetery readings, plots that identify who is buried in a cemetery and where they are buried, as well as old newspapers looking for obituaries.

There are also trips to cemeteries when readings are not available.

The book gets the Genealogical Society another step closer to having a complete list for each cemetery in Monroe County. Prior to releasing the most recent book and the first Center Township book that was devoted to Pioneer Cemetery, the only townships that were left were Center and Sunsbury townships.

New releases include more information that the books released in previous years, including obituaries when available.

Ogden said the Genealogical Society is often contacted by people like VanMeakins, those who are not from Monroe County but have family ties to the area that trace back decades or even centuries.

When that happens, the books provide the answers to the who, where and when.

"There is a gold mine of stuff (in the books) if you are looking for information," Ogden said.

Schaber and Ogden described Monroe County as an early stopping point in the expansion of the country westward.

"I don't think people realize the historical importance (of Monroe County)," Schaber said. "Why people were here and how

(the county) started. People can take pride in knowing their descendants were some of the earliest settlers of the Northwest Territory and some of those settlers were Revolutionary War soldiers."

The preservation becomes even more important when you consider how many records were lost to time and fires in the county.

And it helps people who have never been to Woodsfield make some real Monroe County memories.

That "gold mine" helped VanMeakins on her search for Benjamin Hughes.

After getting a start on her Hughes history at the Parry Museum, Schaber took VanMeakins on a cemetery tour of Sandbar, Sutherland and Stafford, finding most of the grave-stones VanMeakins was looking for and getting pictures of the homeplace

of Benjamin Hughes. And, they found his gravestone, weathered by many years, but not yet lost to history.

As one hunt ends successfully, more continue. Ogden said all of Oaklawn Cemetery is yet to be done, but that will likely come after 12 more smaller cemeteries in Center Township, including Baker-Steed, Fairview Methodist, Gillespie, Gray, Hickenbotham (also known as Cox-Gray-Myers), Moffett, Moose, Morris (also known as McGarry), Mt. Carrick, Neuhart Baptist, Valley (also known as Bucks) and Winland cemeteries.

And the push for preservation continues, by the county's preeminent historical researches.

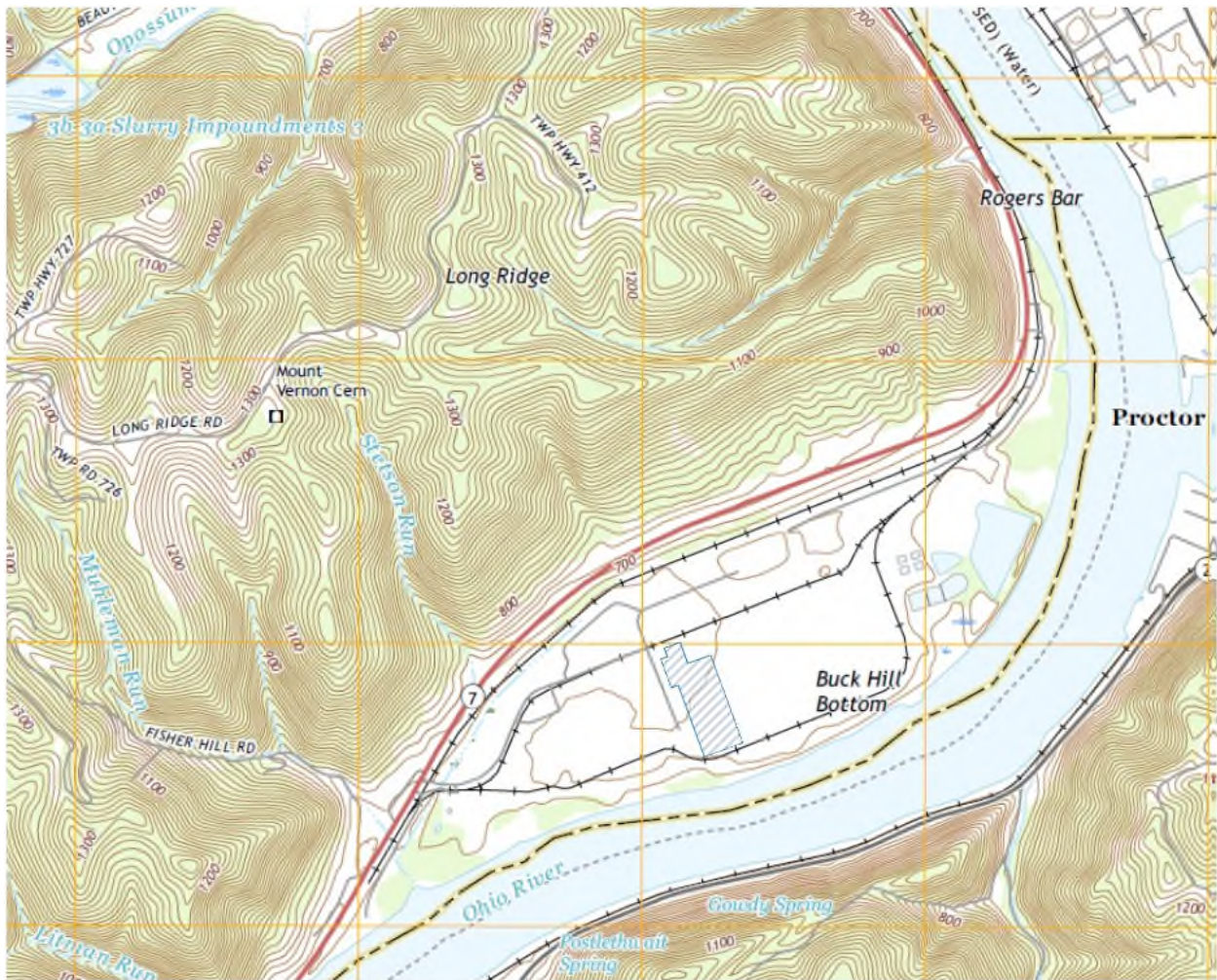

The Facility is located in Hannibal, Monroe County, Ohio. Through this letter of notification application, LREG seeks to amend the certificate previously issued to allow for the use of a hydrogen-natural gas fuel blend of up to 20% hydrogen in the Facility's combustion turbines. Other aspects of the approved Facility remain unchanged.
