





Long Ridge Energy Generation LLC ("LREG") has submitted a letter of notification application to amend a certificate the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") previously granted in Case No. 17-1091-EL-BLN for its Long Ridge Energy Generation facility ("Facility"), a 485 MW electric generation facility. The Facility is located in Hannibal, Monroe County, Ohio. Through this letter of notification application, LREG seeks to amend the certificate previously issued to allow for the use of a hydrogen-natural gas fuel blend of up to 20% hydrogen in the Facility's combustion turbines.
