Dear Chairman French,

On August 26, 2021, The Dayton Power and Light Company doing business as “AES Ohio”, filed a Pre-Application Notification Letter for the above-referenced Project pursuant to Rule 4906-6-03(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code (“OAC”).

AES Ohio hereby supplements that Pre-Application Notification Letter by requesting expedited processing. AES Ohio anticipates that construction of the Project will begin on October 15, 2021, pending approval of this Construction Notice. The anticipated in-service date for the Project is May 31, 2022.

As noted in its August 26, 2021 Letter, this Project falls within the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) requirements for a Letter of Notification application pursuant to OAC Rule 4906-6-05.

Pursuant to OAC 4906-6-04(A), a copy of AES Ohio’s application will be submitted to the executive director or the executive director’s designee and AES Ohio will also submit a check in the amount of \$2,000 to the Treasurer, State of Ohio, for the expedited fees.
