Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4511.63, the Ohio Department of Transportation, District 9 is formally requesting a railroad exemption at the three above mentioned locations. It appears that Norfolk Southern Railway Company owns the rail line at all three crossings and that the rail line has not been used for several years. It is ODOT District 9's belief that eliminating the need for school buses and hazmat vehicles from stopping at these three crossings will result in an increase in safety for the traveling public.
