Dear Attorney Examiner Price:

At the prehearing conference on August 31, 2021 and in response to the Ohio Consumers' Counsel's motion to compel, you ordered the FirstEnergy Utilities to supplement certain discovery responses to OCC by September 17, 2021. And you asked OCC to notify you by September 24, 2021, whether OCC intends to re-depose Mr. Fanelli.<sup>1</sup>

At the request of the FirstEnergy Utilities for OCC to accept a delay, OCC did not object to a twoweek extension for the production of these documents (till October 1, 2021). However, without those documents from FirstEnergy, OCC would appreciate until October 11, 2021, to inform you about OCC's plans for a re-deposing Mr. Fanelli and/or deposing other deponents. If you require a response from OCC today, then OCC's response is that it intends to re-depose Mr. Fanelli.
