The Project involves expanding the substation on Duke Energy Ohio's property or existing easements, expanding the existing substation perimeter fencing, and reconfiguring equipment to accommodate new equipment inside the substation for more efficient and reliable operations. The substation expansion will comprise an area of approximately 0.75 acre, as compared with the existing approximate 10.6-acre Stuart Substation. The chain link perimeter fence of the substation will expand to the south of the existing fence. All the expansion will be within Duke Energy Ohio's property and existing easements. A new fence will also be installed within the existing combined Stuart Substation to separate Duke Energy Ohio's equipment from equipment operated by other electric transmission utilities that currently share the use of the existing 10.6-acre Stuart Substation. Two new access gates and drives will be constructed to access the expanded and reconfigured Duke Energy Ohio Stuart Substation.

The Project also proposes to reuse the existing 138-kV transmission line conductor, which will be shortened by approximately 95 feet and will run from an existing bus structure within the substation to an existing steel three pole structure located north of the Stuart Substation fence.
