{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 2} The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02. Accordingly, DP&L is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.

{¶ 3} On September 10, 2021, Eddie Thomas (Complainant) initiated a complaint against DP&L regarding charges on his electric bill where he alleges, he did not consent to acquiring services from DP&L.

{¶ 4} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(B), a copy of the complaint was mailed to DP&L on September 13, 2021, directing DP&L to file its answer and any responsive pleading within 20 days after September 13, 2021.

{¶ 5} A review of the Commission's records reveals that DP&L has not filed any responsive pleading as required by Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(B).

{¶ 6} DP&L is ordered to file its answer and any other responsive pleading in this matter no later than November 8, 2021.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That DP&L comply with the finding in Paragraph 6. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
