> Re: Case Record 21-0873-TP-COI In the Matter of the Commission's Investigation into Exhaust Relief for Area Code "513"

On August 26, 2021, NANPA filed a petition for relief of the 513 NPA on behalf of the Ohio telecommunications industry ("Industry") which advised the Commission that the 513 NPA was projected to exhaust in the second quarter of 2023.¹ By this letter and in a continuation of its efforts to update the Ohio Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") regarding the status of area code 513, the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA"), hereby notifies the Commission that the projected exhaust date for the 513 numbering plan area ("NPA") has been revised from second quarter 2023 to the fourth quarter of 2023.

The Industry recommended an all-services distributed overlay as the relief method of the 513 NPA and requested the Commission grant the petition no later than December 31, 2021. On September 8, 2021, the Commission issued an Entry in the Case, seeking comments regarding the 513 area code exhaust relief petition filed by NANPA in which initial comments were due by September 22, 2021, and reply comments to be filed by October 4, 2021.

Subsequently, on October 14, 2021, NANPA published the October 2021 Numbering Resource Utilization/Forecast (NRUF) and NPA Exhaust Analysis ("October 2021 NRUF Report") which changed the projected exhaust from second quarter of 2023 (2Q2023) to fourth quarter of 2023 (4Q2023). NANPA notified the industry members involved in the relief planning of the 513 NPA at the time of publication of the new exhaust projection.

Although the projected exhaust date has moved out two quarters, on June 17, 2021, NANPA declared the 513 NPA to be in a jeopardy status³ and respectfully requests the Commission grant the petition for relief no later than December 31, 2021, as requested by the Industry.
