SOLAR GENERATION FUND RIDER

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all retail jurisdictional customers in the Company's electric service territory including those customers taking generation service from a Competitive Retail Electric Service provider.

CHARGES

Pursuant to Am. Sub H. B. 128 (H. B. 128) which became effective on June 30, 2021, all retail jurisdictional customers shall be assessed a charge for the retail recovery of costs related to the solar generation fund for the period up to December 31, 2027.

RATE

The SGF charges or (credits) for each rate schedule are shown in the following tables. The SGF charge or (credit) applies to all customers:
