

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RIDER SGF
Solar Generation Fund Rider

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to any customer that takes electric service under the Company's rate schedules. The Solar Generation Fund Rider ("SGF") charges will apply effective for bills rendered beginning January 1, 2021. This Rider is not avoidable for customers who take electric generation service from a certified supplier.

RATE:

For Rate RS, the Rider SGF charge will be a single monthly flat rate per month. For all other rate schedules listed below, the Rider SGF charges will be a single cents per kWh rate for usage up to 833,000 kWh per month per customer billing account.

PROVISIONS:

Rider SGF is implemented pursuant to Section 3706.46 of the Revised Code.

RIDER UPDATES:

The charges contained in this Rider shall be updated and reconciled on an annual basis. On or about November 15th each year, the Company will file with the PUCO a request for approval of the Rider charges which, unless otherwise ordered by the PUCO, shall become effective on a bill rendered basis on January 1st of each year. This Rider is subject to reconciliation, including, but not limited to increases or refunds. Such reconciliation shall be based solely upon the results of audits ordered by the Commission.
