I am requesting a conference in reference to the CASE #OH3202307229D as I do not agree with the description of "Failure to stop at railroad crossing- H M Cargo Tank Vehicle." I have been driving and maintained a professional Commercial Drivers License for thirty-five years and I have carried a tank endorsement for four years. Safety is my #1 concern, priority, and practice! I strongly disagree with this citation of not stopping at a railroad crossing. At the time of being pulled over and the officer bringing this to my attention, I questioned as to the where the crossing was that he was referring to. He could not specify at the time and conveyed nothing more about this accusation.

Upon returning to my place of employment and discussing with my manager we reviewed my electronic logs via J.J. Keller and we searched Google Maps. In our search, we found that the nearest railroad crossing was fourteen miles/11 minutes prior to the point of getting pulled over. This railroad crossing is on SR 42 of which I frequently travel, and I am confident that I stopped at the light, just before the crossing, which is 15-50 feet in distance as I ALWAYS DO.

I do not feel this citation is right, fair, and reasonable. I would appreciate if this citation and fine could be reconsidered and removed from my driving record.
