MR. KEANEY: This is Mark Keaney, counsel for the Companies. The -- in this proceeding, all parties to this proceeding, the Company, Staff, and all ten intervenors, have unanimously agreed to the terms and conditions of the

Stipulation and Recommendation that have been filed in these dockets on November 1st, 2021.

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Several parties, specifically the Companies, which entail the Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company, Staff, OCC, and OEG, have also filed direct testimony in support of the Stipulation, which was filed in these proceedings on November 15th and 16th of 2021.

In the interest of administrative expedience, the Companies would propose that the parties stipulate to the admission of the Stipulation and Recommendation that had been filed on November 1st, 2021 in this docket, as well as the admission of the direct testimony in support of that unanimous Stipulation, which had been filed by the Companies, Staff, OCC, and OEG.

EXAMINER ADDISON: I will certainly defer ruling on the motion, Mr. Keaney. Perhaps we can take a step back and just mark each exhibit separately as agreeable to the parties.

MR. KEANEY: Sure. So the Companies would mark Exhibit 1. Companies' Exhibit 1 would be the Stipulation and Recommendation filed and docketed on November 1st, 2021.
